The Town of Blacksburg is requesting \$851,952 CDBG funds to carry out the following activities.

The proposed project is a multi-phase is the downtown district. CDBG funds are being requested for Phase I (west side). Blacksburg will apply for ARC funding for the east side later this year. The project activities will include: remove curb and gutters, remove concrete/brick walks and drives, grading, milling of existing asphalt pavement, paving overlay, new concrete sidewalks, stamped asphalt, thermoplastic arrows, specialty paving, new curb and gutters, ADA ramp, canopy trees, shade sails, benches, trash receptacles, pedestrian lights, regulatory signage, erosion control, landscaping, utility relocation and stormwater allowance. This project will be a town wide benefit to 2,100 residents in which 1,264 are LMI. Total Phase I CDBG funding \$851,952 with local matching funds of \$133,659.
