



BOIL WATER ADVISORY

CUSTOMERS OF THE TOWN OF BLACKSBURG

January 23, 2026

The Town of Blacksburg is advising customers located in the areas listed below to **vigorously boil their water for at least one (1) full minute** prior to drinking or cooking. If water is used for drinking, allow the water to cool to a desired temperature after boiling.

Any ice made from water that has not been boiled should not be used for drinking purposes during this advisory.

Affected Areas

All areas located in the following portions of the Blacksburg Water System: South of I-85 between the intersection of W. Pine St. & W. Cherokee St and Hwy5 (downtown and adjacent streets)

Reason for Advisory

An interruption of water service occurred in the affected area. While there is **no confirmed contamination** of the water system, the loss of water pressure creates the **potential for contamination**. As a precautionary measure, residents should boil water for at least one (1) full minute prior to drinking, cooking, brushing teeth, etc., until further notice from the Town.

What's Being Done

The interruption of service has been repaired. Town crews are conducting required testing to ensure water quality meets all regulatory standards.

Repeal of Advisory

The conditions of this **Boil Water Advisory** should be followed until the Town of Blacksburg issues an official **Repeal Notice**. The repeal will be communicated in the same manner as this advisory.

The Town anticipates providing an update by **January 25, 2026** pending water quality test results.
